

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS
OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in special session on **April 12, 2018** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 3:27pm

ROLL CALL

County Commission: Mark Newcomb Chair, Natalia Macker Vice Chair, and Paul Vogelheim were present. Smokey Rhea, and Greg Epstein were absent.

ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. Consideration of Comments as a Cooperating Agency on the Sage Grouse Management Revision Draft EIS

Discussion among the Board included support of the Governor's original plan, requesting more time for greater public involvement, synthesis of work done by Teton County Sage Grouse Working Group, request for 30-day extension of the comment period for cooperating agencies, disappointment on the turn this has taken on the federal level, sensitivity to other counties with BLM land with sage grouse habitat, reaching out to other cooperating counties on final EIS, and concern for citing and referencing the Teton County Comprehensive Plan.

The meeting was recessed at 3:42pm to allow one member to read all the materials and reconvened at 3:46pm.

Discussion among the Board included suggested changes to the proposed comments.

A motion was made by Commissioner Macker and seconded by Commissioner Vogelheim to approve the cooperating agency comments on the Greater Sage Grouse draft EIS as amended today. Chair Newcomb called for the vote. The vote showed 3-0 and the motion carried.
