- 1) In the past two weeks (1/1 to 1/14), there were 454 new cases reported. This is up 189% from the previous two-week period. 49% of these have been due to community spread.
- 2) As of 1/14/2021, we have 290 known active cases. Statistics overview can be found [here](#).
- 3) **Health Orders and Recommendations:**
  - As of January 13<sup>th</sup>, the Teton County District Health Officer has re-issued the recommendation for Teton County to [Gather Within Household Members Only](#). This is effective January 13<sup>th</sup> through January 27<sup>th</sup>.
  - The 19<sup>th</sup> continuation of Order #1, #2, and #3 are active from January 9<sup>th</sup> through January 25<sup>th</sup>. Click [here](#) to view the orders.
  - [First continuation of the Statewide Face Covering Order](#) requiring individuals to wear masks throughout the State of Wyoming, including State and County Buildings is active from January 9<sup>th</sup> through January 25<sup>th</sup>.
    - People must wear a mask in any business, not just in retail or commercial settings. A business is defined as any type of business entity (including non-profits) that employ or engage workers or volunteers. This includes office spaces and back of the house at restaurants where the public does not normally enter.
- 4) **UPDATE:** Delays in case investigation and contact tracing are currently happening due to the extreme increase in COVID-19 cases. Teton County Health Department is still attempting to contact all positive cases, but it may take multiple days to reach any one individual due to the current caseload.
