

QUALIFYING FOR A WOOD STOVE REBATE



To qualify for a Teton County Wood Stove Rebate, all the following statements must be true:

1. My wood stove was manufactured before 1990 and does not meet federal EPA standards.
2. My wood stove is currently installed and useable.
3. I own the home in which the wood stove is located, or I have a written authorization from the owner allowing me to apply for a Wood Stove Rebate in their name.

Once you determine that you qualify for the program, you will need to come to the Planning Department, located on the second floor of the Teton County Administration Building located at 200 S. Willow Street. We will have you fill out a Wood Stove Rebate application, and then you will need to do the following:

1. First, schedule a time to have your woodstove inspected by a Teton County Building Inspector. You must be home when the inspector arrives. After the inspection is complete, the inspector will sign your voucher. The inspector will then give you the yellow copy of the voucher, which is for your records. (Please keep this until you receive your check.)
2. Next, take your stove to the Teton County Transfer Station. Tell them you are dropping off a woodstove for the rebate program, and you will receive a receipt from them. **YOU MUST KEEP THIS RECEIPT AND TURN IT IN TO THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT TO RECEIVE YOUR REBATE.** Without the receipt we have no proof it was delivered to the Transfer Station. Please note that there may not be someone available to help you unload your stove so please bring help with you if needed.
3. Finally, bring the Teton County Transfer Station receipt to the Planning Department, located on the second floor of the Teton County Administrative Building located at 200 S. Willow Street. We will then have you sign a voucher which will be submitted to the Treasurer for payment. You should receive your check within 10 business days.

Please Note: You have 30 days from the time you submit your application to turn in your receipt to receive your rebate. After 30 days your application will expire. There are limited funds each year for the program, so rebates are paid out on a first come first serve basis.
