Subject: 2023 Liquor License Renewal

ILC 3535 Holdings LLC dba The Copper Bar

Statement / Purpose: 2023 Liquor License Renewals per WS § 12-4-104 for ILC 3535 Holdings LLC dba The Copper Bar

Background / Description (Pros & Cons):

On October 26, 2022 the Teton County Clerk's Office received verbal notification from a county resident that The Copper Bar was currently closed and had been for several years. Upon talking with the Wyoming Liquor Division, they provided the following information:

1. A retail license was issued to ILC 3535 Holdings LLC dba The Copper Bar on June 20, 2017.
2. The Copper Bar has not placed an order with the Wyoming Liquor Division since September 2020.
3. The Wyoming Department of Revenue, Excise Tax Division records indicate that no sales have been reported since September 2020 and sales reporting was sporadic before that time period.
4. The previous renewal applications for 2020 and 2021 show the establishment as operational even though they did not report any sales.
5. Based on a January 20, 2019 email from the Wyoming Liquor Division, it was confirmed that The Copper Bar had been closed, non-operational since approximately May or June of 2018; the previous application (2018 renewal) showed full-time operational status except for being closed during May and September 2018; they placed an WLD order in January 2019 and the last order before that was May 2018; there were sales reported to the Excise tax Division for March 2018 and there were zero sales report submitted for August 2018

The Teton County Clerk's Office has not ever received a request from ILC 3535 Holdings LLC dba The Copper Bar for non-operational status, nor has there been a request to move from full-time to seasonal status after the issuance of the retail liquor license.

Per WS § 12-1-101 "Operational" means offering for sale on an ongoing weekly basis to the general public alcoholic liquor and malt beverages as authorized under a license or permit issued under this title;

Per WS § 12-1-103 A license or permit authorized by this title shall not be held by, issued or transferred to:

(iv) Any licensee who fails to demonstrate that his licensed alcoholic or malt beverage enterprise will be operational in a planned but not physically functional building within one (1) year after a license or permit has been issued or transferred, or if holding a license, fails to open his business in a functional building within one (1) year after license issuance or transfer and remain operational thereafter. Upon a showing of good cause by the licensee and for an additional period of not to exceed one (1) year, the local licensing authority may extend the time period in which the business or enterprise of the licensee is required to become operational or open for business pursuant to this paragraph. Any license or permit in violation of this paragraph shall not be renewed by the local licensing authority and once the enterprise is operational or open for business, no licensee shall be eligible to repeat the grace periods made available by this paragraph without the consent of the local licensing authority due to extraordinary circumstances. For purposes of this paragraph "remain operational" means operational consecutively, in any license term year, for twelve (12) months or for not less than three (3) months if determined by the local licensing authority to be a seasonal operation.



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Pursuant to WS § 12-4-104 (b) "If a renewal or transfer hearing, the hearing shall be held no later than thirty (30) days preceding the expiration date of the license or permit." The current licenses expire on January 6, 2022.

The Board of County Commissioners are to review all liquor license approvals according to the following factors:

1. Whether the people residing in the vicinity of the license would be adversely or seriously affected.
2. Whether the purpose of the Liquor Laws of the State of Wyoming would be carried out by the renewal of this license.
3. Whether the number, type and location of existing licenses meet the needs of the vicinity under consideration.
4. Whether the renewal of the license would meet or satisfy the desires of the residents of the county.
5. Whether any reasonable restrictions or standards should be imposed upon the applicant.

Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §12-4-106 a license is considered a personal privilege and the term of a license is normally one year, however, the Board of County Commissioners may issue the license for less than one year to coincide with the annual renewal date in January.

Stakeholder Analysis & Involvement: Published in local newspaper of record, on county website, and posted at the liquor establishment. No comments were received.

Fiscal Impact: A total of \$1,500.00 in license fees as follows:

Legal Review: Gingery

Staff Input / Recommendation: Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §12-4-104(d) the Wyoming Department of Revenue, Liquor Division, must certify all renewal applications as complete prior to approval by the Board of County Commissioners. The Liquor Division has reviewed the renewal applications and certified the applications as complete.

However, even though the application is complete, the liquor license has not been utilized or operational for more than a year. Holding a retail liquor license solely to gain blue sky value on the open market is not the purpose of issuing retail liquor permits. The retailer has not been operational and the license should not be renewed. After repeated attempts to contact the applicant, the Clerk has received no response.



Re: The Copper Bar Retail Liquor License Renewal

As you have read in Shelley Fairbanks's staff report on the renewal of The Copper Bar's retail liquor license recommendation, the Clerk's Office was contacted on October 26, 2022 regarding the operational status of the Copper Bar.

Upon this notification, my office contacted the Wyoming Liquor Division and was informed that there have been zero orders of alcohol since September of 2020. Also, the Wyoming Department of Revenue have indicated that no sales have been reported since September 2020 and sales reporting was sporadic before that time period.

At this time, I repeatedly tried to reach out to both the owner and the listed contact by both phone and email and received no response. It's listing on google states it is permanently closed and the number listed is out of service.

WS § 12-1-103 speaks to the requirement of a business being operational. Although it lists that the Copper Bar has been operational in the last two years of applications, there is nothing that shows it indeed has been open.

It is my recommendation, as Teton County Clerk, that this application not be renewed for 2023.
